TAX STATUS OF DONORS

Message from Maria Thompson, Gift Aid Organizer for St Augustine's:-

- The Diocese on behalf of parishes claims 25p on every £1 given under the Gift Aid Scheme. If you donate through a standing order or through the envelope system you need to check that you are paying sufficient income tax to cover the amount reclaimed from HMRC. This will prevent you facing an unexpected personal request from HMRC to repay tax if you have not paid sufficient tax during the 19/20 tax year.
 - There is a very simple way to check:-
- £1 donation x 52 weeks = £52 x 125% = £65 less £52 = £13 tax paid per year
- £5 donation x 52 weeks = £260 x 125% =£325 less £260 = £65 tax paid per year
- Please check that your donation is covered, if not just advise Maria when you collect your box of envelopes and she will make the necessary adjustment to your tax status. Can parishioners who make their donations through standing orders also advise Maria if their tax status has changed. She can be contacted either at Church or by email at iwantagiftaidbox@btinternet.com. Just advise her of your name, address, box number or state the amount you donate monthly by standing order.

To the parishioners of both St Augustine's and St Anne's, if you have not done so already, I would like you to consider taking a box of Offertory Envelopes when they start again at the beginning of April. If you are a taxpayer, please sign a Gift Aid Form, to enable your parish to claim the tax back on your donations given through your numbered envelopes. Or you may prefer to make a monthly donation direct from your bank into the bank account of your parish. Either way your donations can be recorded to fulfil the regulations for Gift Aid. Using our Weekly Offertory Envelopes establishes the good habit of **regular and responsible giving** to support the Church. God loves a cheerful giver! Today more than ever, everybody's financial support is needed to maintain the worship and mission of the Church in Gateshead. It cannot be left to the OAP's alone to carry the can! The younger generation of Catholics need to step up to the plate!
