The New Lectionaries

The Lectionary is the books containing the Scripture Readings that we use at Mass. The current translation is being changed and so from the First Sunday of Advent we will be listening to a different translation of the Bible. This means that each parish needs to buy a new set of books for use at Mass. In this new publication there are four volumes to be used throughout the year and a separate Book of the Gospel. As you might guess these books are expensive – the four-volume set for use in Church costs £695 and the Book of the Gospels is £275 – there is also the need to buy a small 'study' edition set of four volumes for use when Mass is celebrated in a small room or for Masses outside and this costs £250. There is a further edition that I think would be better suited for St. Anne's and Holy Rosary, the Chapel Edition, which costs £395.

If you would like to make a special donation to help with these costs in any of our Parishes, it would be a tremendous help.
